

Rules and Regulations



General Information

- 1- ALL guests must stop at the office when entering, register (required by law), and pay guest fee. Failure to register will result in expulsion with no refund.
- 2- Do NOT cut, break, or damage any live foliage, or drive nails, screws, or hooks into trees. Please don't scavenge any wood from the campground.
- 3- Quiet hours are from 11:00 pm until 7:00 am but excessive noise is not permitted at any time. Alcohol is allowed, but anyone drinking excessively will be removed. Any guest removed due to poor behavior will not receive a refund. Alcoholic beverages must be kept secure.
- 4- Please put trash IN the dumpster. Don't leave any items on or around it. Glass/plastic bottles and cans go in recycle bins 1 & 2. Paper and cardboard go in bin 3. No bags in recycle bins. Children often can't reach, or they place items incorrectly, so please have an adult remove the trash.
- 5- Parents are responsible for their children at all times. Children must not be left unattended. All children must be back at the site by 11 pm. Children under six must be accompanied by an adult in the restroom.
- 6- Pets must be on a leash and physically under your control at all times, and must never be left unattended. You must clean up all pet waste. Excessive barking is not permitted. Maximum: two pets per site.
- 7- Always carry a flashlight after dark.
- 8- We appreciate your help in keeping our cottages and campground clean. Please do not throw cigarette butts or other litter on the ground.
- 9- Public telephone is located on the front of our office building.

- 10- Be safety conscious- we are not responsible for loss or injury of any kind from (including but not limited to) fire, theft, tidal waves, weather, falling trees, electrical failure, or meteorites - so please be careful.
- 11- Office Hours: 8:30 a.m. until 11:00 p.m.
- 12- If you have any questions or concerns, please let us know at the office. We will do our best to help.

Campers

- 1- Check-out requires you to be packed and off the site before 1:00 p.m. If you would like to stay longer, you must reserve a site by 10:00 a.m. Your current site may already be reserved by someone else, but we'll do our very best to help you. Failure to check out by 1 p.m. will result in a penalty equal to 1 day's site fee. If this also conflicts with an incoming reservation, you will be billed their first night's fee in addition.
- 2- Please help us keep the grounds clean by ensuring all personal items and trash have been removed from your site before leaving.
- 3- Only wood or paper should be burned in fire pits. No glass or garbage!
- 4- Please do not wash or dry dishes in rest rooms or laundromat.

Pool

- 1- Pool rules are posted inside and outside the pool area. You are responsible for reading and following these rules before entering. You are also responsible for ensuring any children under your care follow these rules. There is no lifeguard on duty, so Ocean View will not be held liable for loss or injury of any kind. Children 14 and under must be with an adult.
- 2- You will be removed from Ocean View if you enter the pool area when the pool is closed.
- 3- Pool hours are 10:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.
